

GUIDELINES FOR HUMANITARIAN AID (HA)

These are some guidelines for those who wish to donate items for the Afghan people in the Kandahar area. Donation items can be for any gender or age group (infant on up) and any size:

Pants
Shoes (athletic type, no light up)
Socks
Shirts (no American flags)
Jackets
Gloves
Scarves

Blankets, quilts, etc.

School supplies:

Backpacks or Bookbags (without labels or writing on them)
Pencils (preferably wooden with erasers)
Ink Pens (any size, shape or color)
Notebooks (100 sheet wirebound or composition books)
Coloring Books (*No religious themes or anything with pigs*)
Crayons (small boxes)
Rulers
Erasers
Pencil Sharpeners
Scissors (small, rounded tip)
Glue Sticks

Teacher kits can be made out of:

Flash Cards for Mathematics, Science and English or the Alphabet Instruction Manuals in:
Mathematics, Writing, English (including alphabet and other visual aids) and Science.
Index Cards
Rolling Ball Liquid Pens; tape (masking and scotch); large scissors; paper clips; colored push-pins; art stencils; stickers for good work; sticky pads; notebooks; markers (thick & thin); chalk & erasers; mechanical graphite pencil refills; staplers with staples, highlighters, bottled glue, large boxes of crayons, straight and protracted rulers, etc.

Medical Supplies:

Assembled First Aid Kits:
Band-aids/bandages/medical tape/scissors
Over the counter medicines
Hand sanitizer
Diapers
Feminine hygiene products

Prohibited Items

- 1. Backpacks**
- 2. Batteries**
- 3. Sharp objects**
- 4. Toys with wires**
