Adopt-a-Soldier Project

The project called "Adopt-a-Soldier" focuses on supporting a deployed U.S. military service member or unit stationed in harm's way who is referred by a friend or family member in our community. Each homeroom "adopts" a service person, learns about the person and prepares care packages for him/her.

Class Project Captain

Each homeroom is assigned a Class Project Captain* (e.g., student volunteer) to oversee and assist with the Adopt-a-Soldier project. Duties include:

- Works with teacher to select and carry out class assignments
- Serves as liaison between teacher, students/parents, service person, service person's family, and River Green Outreach
- Sends announcements/ information to students' parents through flyers, class newsletter, and class website about Adopt-a-Soldier activities, shipping schedules, and list of items to donate
- Collects letters and donations in classroom's drop box

* Elementary schools: must be an adult class parent or room mom
